Format: there will be a Student Forum to allow students to network and to discuss key issues for discussion with the invited speakers. Exhibition space for storyboards will be provided.

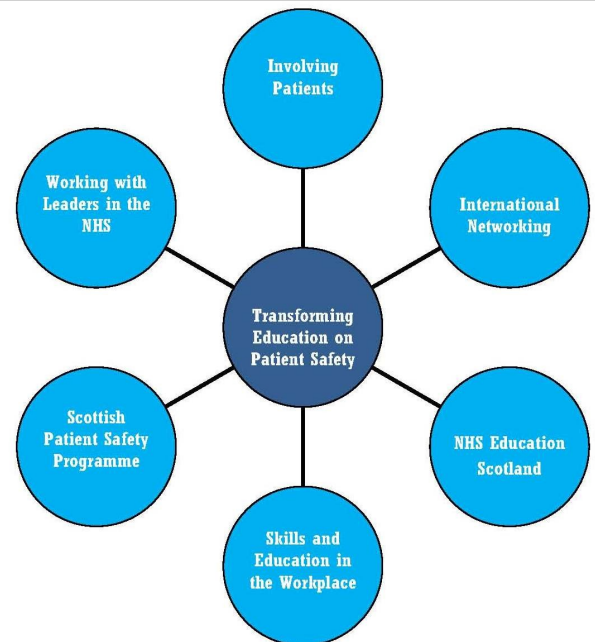
